Teaching Arrangement for the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2022/2023

Dear Postgraduate Students,

We would like to inform you about the following teaching arrangements for the 2nd semester of academic year 2022/2023:

1. University Almanac and Important Dates

The classes for the coming semester will begin on **5 January 2023** and you may refer to the Graduate School's webpage for the 2022/2023 University Almanac and Important Dates for details: <https://grs.um.edu.mo/index.php/current-students/university-almanac-and-important-dates/>

2. Teaching Mode

All teaching activities will be normally arranged and classes will mainly be arranged on a face-to-face teaching basis. Students are required to attend the face-to-face classes on campus and the requirement of 80% class attendance will be applied as normal. The University will arrange online classes for the international students who fail to return to the campus on schedule due to the preventive measures or quarantine requirements implemented by the Macao SAR Government.

3. Class Arrangement for Teachers and Students Holding Red or Yellow Macao Health Code

Students holding red or yellow Macao Health Code will not be allowed to attend the face-to-face classes, thesis oral defence and report presentation. Furthermore, they will not be allowed to enter the teaching buildings or use any facilities in the campus. They must declare the red or yellow Macao Health Code on the [online platform \(https://isw.um.edu.mo/eforms/studenthealthcode.html\)](https://isw.um.edu.mo/eforms/studenthealthcode.html) **every day** to apply for leave of absence. Teachers will provide appropriate assistance to the concerned students on studies and students will not be considered absent for the said period. The above-mentioned online platform will be available from 5 January 2023. Students please pay close attention on it.

If a teacher holds a red or yellow Macao Health Code, his/her classes will be cancelled or re-arranged. Students are advised to pay close attention to teachers' notice and student emails.



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4. Teaching Materials

All teaching materials, e.g. teaching videos, PPT, etc. are owned by the University and the teachers. Students are **NOT** allowed to share or upload any of them on social media, such as YouTube, WeChat, etc., and other electronic platforms.
