2nd Notice of Teaching Arrangement for the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2022/2023

Dear Postgraduate Students,

In order to reduce the impact on the teaching arrangement during the transitional period of the pandemic in Macao, the following adjustments are made for the 2nd semester of academic year 2022/2023:

1. University Almanac and Important Dates (remains unchanged)

The classes for the coming semester will begin on <u>5 January 2023</u> and you may refer to the Graduate School's webpage for the 2022/2023 University Almanac and Important Dates for details:

2. Teaching Mode

- All classes will be conducted online for the period of <u>5-14 January 2023</u>.
- The teaching mode for the classes <u>after Lunar New Year Recess (30 January</u> <u>2023 onwards</u>) will be announced in due course. The University is closely monitoring the situation of COVID-19 and will make necessary adjustments to the teaching arrangement in accordance with the prevention measures of the Macao SAR Government and the advice of the Education and Youth Development Bureau. Please pay close attention to the University notice and emails about any updates.

3. Application for Leave of Absence due to Infection of COVID-19

If students are not feeling well to attend the online classes during 5-14 January 2023 due to infection of COVID-19, they can submit the red Macao Health Code or the "Certificate of COVID-19 Infection" on the <u>online platform</u> (<u>https://isw.um.edu.mo/eforms/studenthealthcode.html</u>) <u>every day</u> to apply for leave of absence. The above-mentioned online platform will be available from 5 January 2023. Students please pay close attention on it.
