3rd Notice of Teaching Arrangement for the 2nd Semester of Academic Year 2022/2023

Dear Postgraduate Students,

We would like to announce that **all classes will mainly be arranged on a face-to-face teaching basis from 30 January 2023 (Monday)**. Please find below the latest teaching arrangement for the 2nd semester of academic year 2022/2023:

2. Teaching Mode

All classes will mainly be arranged on a face-to-face teaching basis from 30 January 2023 (Monday) onwards. Students are required to attend the face-to-face classes on campus and the requirement of 80% class attendance will be applied as normal. If students fail to return to the campus on schedule due to individual reasons, please contact the Graduate School at email: gradschool@um.edu.mo.

3. Preventive Measures

- Starting from the resumption of face-to-face classes on 30 January 2023, all students are required to perform a rapid antigen test and upload the result to the Rapid Antigen Test Reporting Platform (<https://eservice.ssm.gov.mo/generalrat>) every day before you return to the University for face-to-face classes, examinations, thesis oral defence or report presentation, **except for the students who have been infected with COVID-19 after 28 November 2022.**
- Students who are testing “positive” for COVID-19 cannot return to the University for face-to-face classes, examinations, thesis oral defence or report presentation. Students can apply for leave of absence by uploading the positive result to the above-mentioned platform and inform the teacher(s) concerned in writing together with the screenshot of the uploaded result page. Students can also seek medical consultation if necessary, and present the medical certificate as a proof of absence due to illness to the teacher(s) concerned. 4. Vaccination

COVID-19 vaccine can reduce the risk of morbidity, severe diseases and death after infection. All students suitable for vaccination are advised to get vaccinated and receive booster shots.

Students who have vaccinated or received booster shots are advised to upload your COVID-19 vaccination information on the UM online platform (<https://isw.um.edu.mo/eforms/vaccination.html>) ASAP. After students submit the "Proof of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccination" on the online platform, the University will verify the relevant documents. Students may check your submitted COVID-19 vaccination records on the online platform two to five working days after the submission.
