### 3<sup>rd</sup> Notice of Teaching Arrangement for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester of Academic Year 2021/2022

Dear Postgraduate Students,

We would like to announce that all teaching activities will continue to be conducted in face-to-face teaching mode from **10 February 2022**. Students should pay close attention to the Announcement of the Special Webpage against Epidemics of the Health Bureau of the Macao SAR (<https://www.ssm.gov.mo/apps1/PreventCOVID-19/en.aspx#clg17610>).

We expect some students to return home during the Lunar New Year Recess period. If these students cannot return to the University on schedule due to the preventive measures implemented by the Macao SAR Government, they will be required to notify the Graduate School in details ASAP via email ([gradschool@um.edu.mo](mailto:gradschool@um.edu.mo)). The University will take their situations into consideration. If the application is approved, the University will offer special class arrangements for these students, otherwise they will be considered **ABSENT**. According to the General Rules Governing PhD and Other Doctoral Degree Programmes, and General Rules Governing Master's Degree & Postgraduate Certificate / Diploma Programmes, **student who is ABSENT from a course for more than 20% of the teaching period in the aggregate will NOT be allowed to take the final examination and will receive a failing grade.**
