6th Notice of Teaching Arrangement for the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2021/2022

Dear Postgraduate Students,

Considering the situation of pandemic and to comply with Macao SAR Government's preventive measures against COVID-19, the University has suspended all teaching activities (including all face-to-face and online classes) this week (5-10 October). **All classes will be conducted ONLINE starting from next week (11 October) until further notice.**

Please be reminded that **students should be ready for resumption of face-to-face classes ANYTIME.** If the situation of COVID-19 is getting stable and improving, the classes will resume to face-to-face teaching mode immediately. **According to the advice from the Education and Youth Development Bureau (the DSEDJ), starting from 25 October onwards, staff and students of tertiary education institutions in Macao are required to present the proof of having received at least the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine or the proof of negative nucleic acid test result which has been sampled within 7 days before entering the University.**

After resumption of face-to-face classes, **online classes will NOT be provided** for the students who are eligible for face-to-face classes but fail to provide the abovementioned proof, or fail to return to the campus for classes due to immigration policy or any other reasons. Students will be considered **ABSENT** during the said period. **According to General Rules Governing PhD and Other Doctoral Degree Programmes, and General Rules Governing Master's Degree & Postgraduate Certificate / Diploma Programmes, student who is ABSENT from a course for more than 20% of the teaching period in the aggregate will NOT be allowed to take the final examination and will receive a failing grade for that course.**

The University strongly urges students to reduce mobility and stay in your usual place of residence in Macao SAR, Zhuhai or Zhongshan. Students are also advised to get the COVID-19 vaccine at your earliest convenience to protect yourselves. You can make a vaccine appointment via the COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment System (<https://eservice.ssm.gov.mo/covidvacbook/Booking?lang=en>).

Students must pay attention to personal hygiene and are reminded to wear a mask properly, wash hands frequently, keep a distance and avoid crowd gathering. Students are advised to strengthen self-health management and pay close attention to your
