Details of UM's English Proficiency Requirements

- i) Applicants who received their Bachelor's / Master's degree from a university where the medium of instruction was not English are required to provide any of the following as proof of English proficiency:
- Obtained a TOEFL* score of 550 (paper-based examination) / 80 (Internet-based examination) or above or,
- An IELTS* score of 6.0 or above with no sub-score lower than 5.5 or,
- College English Test (CET) score is acceptable to some academic units, please visit corresponding website of each academic unit for details.
- *Note: TOEFL and IELTS scores are valid for two years from the test date.
- ii) Applicants who received their Bachelor's/Master's degree from a university where the medium of instruction was English are required to provide a proof of English as the medium of instruction, if deemed necessary, issued by the applicants' university where their Bachelor's/Master's degree was obtained (UM's current students and graduates are not required to provide such proof if the medium of instruction of the programme is English).
