Candidates who are not native speakers, but hold a relevant Bachelor's degree taught in Portuguese are not required to submit language certificate.
	Master of Arts in Chinese History and Culture	Submission of English Proficiency is not compulsory, English proficiency assessment may be arranged by the academic unit.
	Master of Fine Arts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Follow UM's English proficiency requirements in general*. Mainland China's Graduate Entrance Exam score and CET4 score will also be accepted for reference. English proficiency assessment will be arranged by the academic unit depending on the research direction of the applicant. Applicants must hold a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. Submission of CV (with detailed exhibition record, if any) and art portfolio which contains 10 to 20 images of the applicant's work is required.

*Details of UM’s English Proficiency Requirements

- i. Applicants who received their Bachelor/Master’s degree from a university where the medium of instruction was not English are required to provide any of the following as proof of English proficiency:
 - Obtained a Level 6 of the College English Test (CET) score of 430 or;
 - Obtained a TOEFL# score of 550 (paper-based examination) / 80 (internet-based examination) or;
 - An IELTS# score of 6.0 or above with no sub-score lower than 5.5 or;
 - Passed the Level 4 or Level 8 of the Test for English Majors (TEM).

#Note: TOEFL and IELTS scores are valid for two years from the test date.

- ii. Applicants who received their Bachelor/Master’s degree from a university where the medium of instruction was English are required to provide a proof of English as the medium of instruction, if deemed necessary, issued by the applicants’ university where their Bachelor/Master’s degree was obtained (UM’s current students and graduates are not required to provide such proof if the medium of instruction of the programme is English).
