Face-to-Face, Oral Defence and Report Presentation Permit for 1st Semester of Academic Year 2021/2022

Important Notice: All postgraduate students MUST READ it carefully!

Dear Postgraduate Students,



To comply with Macao SAR Government's preventive measures against COVID-19 and to strengthen anti-epidemic measures on campus, the University has well prepared for attending face-to-face classes, oral defence or report presentation. According to the information students recently declared in the "**Important Declaration for Attending Face-to-Face Classes, Oral Defence or Report Presentation**", the University will generate "**Face-to-Face Class Permit**" for students starting from 15 September 2021. You will be required to obtain a "**Green Permit**" every day before attending the face-to-face classes, oral defence or report presentation. If you obtain a "**Red Note**" on any given day, you will NOT be allowed to attend any face-to-face class, oral defence or report presentation during that day.

	<p>Reasons include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Self-declaration: Did not complete “Important Declaration for Attending Face-to-Face Classes, Oral Defence or Report Presentation”.• NAT Result: Did not submit negative result of nucleic acid test.• 14-day Req.: Did not fulfill the 14-day self-health management requirement.• Online Class : Online classes granted by the University. <p>If students are not allowed to attend the face-to-face classes because of the first 3 reasons (Self-declaration, NAT Result or 14-day Req.), students’ access to online instructional materials will be suspended from 15 September. Their classes will also be considered <u>absent</u> during the said period. Students are advised to contact the Graduate School at email: gradschool@um.edu.mo as soon as possible for the follow-up action.</p>

According to Macao SAR Government’s preventive measures, students **must meet the following TWO requirements before attending the face-to-face classes, oral defence or report presentation:**

1. Students must return to their residence in Macao, Zhuhai or Zhongshan 14 days before the face-to-face classes, oral defence or report presentation; and
2. If students or their housemates have ever been to areas outside Macao, Zhuhai or Zhongshan after 6 August 2021, they must complete the nucleic acid test with negative result within 5 days before the start of face-to-face classes, oral defence or report presentation.
