Rules for Supervisors for PhD and Master's Students

(A) PhD Principal Supervisors

1. A UM Assistant Professor or above, who holds a PhD degree should be eligible to be a principal supervisor.
2. Once the principal supervisor is no longer a UM academic staff, a new principal supervisor is required.

(B) Supervisors/Mentors for Master Students

1. A supervisor/mentor must be assigned to each Master's student upon his/her registration during the first semester.
2. If a student chooses a new supervisor/mentor and the new supervisor/mentor accepts, the new supervisor/mentor shall act accordingly. Otherwise, the original supervisor/mentor shall continue to act as the supervisor/mentor.
3. Once the supervisor/mentor is no longer a UM academic staff, a new supervisor/mentor is required.

(C) Co-supervisors for PhD and Master's Students:

1. When a UM academic staff recruits PhD or Master's students at the age of 62 or above, an internal co-supervisor who is also a UM academic staff is required.
2. The internal co-supervisor should normally be the principal supervisor when the principal supervisor is no longer a UM academic staff.
3. Non-UM academic staff is not eligible to be a principal supervisor, but s/he can be appointed as a co-supervisor if necessary.

(D) Exceptions

Exceptions may be permitted with the approval of the Rector or Vice Rector (Academic Affairs).

Remark: The above-mentioned UM academic staff excludes non-regular appointment.
