Preventive Measures against COVID-19 that to be Implemented from 21 February 2022 Collection of Proofs of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccination and Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result

Dear Postgraduate Students,

According to the advice from the Education and Youth Development Bureau (the DSEDJ), <u>starting</u> from 21 February 2022, staff and students of tertiary education institutions in Macao must present proof of completing 2 doses of the primary series of COVID-19 vaccine 14 days ago, when entering the campus. Those who were not fully vaccinated 14 days ago (receiving 2 doses of mRNA vaccines or Inactivated vaccines in the primary series) need to take nucleic acid test every 7 days.

If students fail to provide the abovementioned proof, they will NOT be allowed to enter the University or use any facilities in the campus, including the library, computer rooms, laboratories and residential colleges, etc. from 21 February. These students will be prohibited to attend the classes, thesis oral defence and report presentation on campus and will also be considered <u>ABSENT</u> during the said period. <u>According to the University's rules, student who is ABSENT from a course for more than 20% of the teaching period in the aggregate will NOT be allowed to take the final examination and will receive a failing grade for that course.</u>

For students who are planning to hold the "Proof of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccination" for the classes, thesis oral defence and report presentation on campus

- If you have completed two doses of COVID-19 vaccine, please upload the COVID-19 vaccination information ASAP. Your vaccination record will then be updated accordingly.
- If you are planning to hold only the "Proof of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccination" for the classes, thesis oral defence and report presentation on campus, you must complete two doses of COVID-19 vaccine on or before 7 February (7 February + 14 days → 21 February). Please upload the COVID-19 vaccination information ASAP after receiving the vaccine. Your vaccination record will then be updated accordingly.
- If you complete two doses of COVID-19 vaccine on or after 8 February, please upload the COVID-19 vaccination information ASAP after receiving the vaccine. Your vaccination record will then be updated accordingly. Please note that you will still be required to submit the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" every week until you are fully vaccinated for 14 days.
- NOTE: If you complete only one dose of COVID-19 vaccine, you will be required to submit the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" every week from 18 February until you are fully vaccinated for 14 days.

For students who are planning to hold the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" for the classes, thesis oral defence and report presentation on campus

- If you are planning to hold the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" for the classes, thesis oral defence and report presentation on campus, you must undergo nucleic acid test and submit the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" every week until you are fully vaccinated for 14 days.
- You are required to obtain a negative nucleic acid test result at designated locations at Macao SAR, Zhuhai or Zhongshan, and submit the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" during Friday morning 09:00 to Monday morning 09:00 every week. Furthermore, you must also ensure that the negative nucleic acid test result obtained can cover all of your classes in the following week.
- If you fail to submit the "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result" during the abovementioned period, late submission will NOT be accepted.

Link to Collection of Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result (Students)

This link is now available every week from Friday morning 09:00 to Monday morning 09:00, for the students who have not received any COVID-19 vaccine. Starting from 18 February, it will be available every week from Friday morning 09:00 to Monday morning 09:00, for the students who are not fully vaccinated for 14 days.

Submission Summary of the "Proof of Receiving COVID-19 Vaccination" and "Proof of Negative Nucleic Acid Test Result"

Preventive Measures against COVID-19 that Implemented from 25 October 2021:

Staff and students of tertiary education institutions in Macao are required to present the proof of having received at least the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine or the proof of negative nucleic acid test result which has been sampled within 7 days before entering the University.

Preventive Measures against COVID-19 that to be Implemented from 21 February 2022:
